

Botanical Name: ANNUAL COLOR

Common Name: ANNUAL COLOR

Flowers: Showy flat ray flowers on stout stems

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Seasonal

General: For maximum impact, concentrate color in strategically placed patches tucked into planting beds instead of scattering flowers throughout your yard. No matter how small your planting bed may be, a burst of one color will brighten your landscape. Use color to invite guests to the front door, patio or walkway.



Botanical Name: *Armeria maritima*

Common Name: SEA PINK

Flowers: Compact heads with rose-pink flowers.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Spring-Summer.

General: Full sun, tufted mounds spreading to 1 ft. tall with 6 in. long, stiff, grass like leaves.

Small white to rose pink flowers in tight, round clusters at top of 6 – 10 in. stalks. Blooms from early spring to late fall. Sturdy dependable plants for edging walks and borders, good in rock gardens

Botanical Name: *Coreopsis verticillata* 'Moonbeam'
Common Name: MOONBEAM THREADLEAF COREOPSIS

Flowers: Daisy like.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Spring through summer.

General: Full sun. Easy to grow members of the sunflower family yielding a profusion of yellow, orange, maroon, or reddish flowers reaching a height of 1-1/2 – 2 ft. tall.

Use in borders, in naturalized areas, in cottage gardens, or anywhere in the landscape. Good plant for areas with poor, dry soils.



Botanical Name: *Dietses vegeta*
Common Name: AFRICAN IRIS

Flowers: Eye-catching, iris-like flowers.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Spring through fall.

General: Full sun to partial shade, evergreen perennials reaching a height to 2 ft. tall. Fan shaped clumps or narrow. Stiff, iris-like leaves.

With its unusual flowers, attractive shape, the yellow wild iris is a versatile garden plant. Its Drought, heat and cold tolerance make the *Dietses* an excellent choice for an accent plant, around pools or ponds and shrub borders.

Botanical Name: Hemerocallis x
Common Name: HYBRID DAYLILY

Flowers: 6 inches wide flowers
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green
Bloom Time: Late spring to summer

General: Plant in full sun, Hemerocallis grows in clumps of arching, sword-shaped leaves from 1 ft. in height to some reaching 6 ft. tall.

Daylilies are simply superb garden perennials. Gorgeous, lily-like flowers come in every shade and color. Use in borders, mass on banks, along driveways, near pools and streams.



Botanical Name: Loropetalum chinense 'Burgundy'
Common Name: BURGUNDY CHINESE FRINGE

Flowers: Clusters of fragrant, fringe-like flowers.
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green, Purple, Red
Bloom Time: Blooms in spring; reblooms through summer and fall.

General: Full sun, evergreen shrub reaching a height of 5 – 8 ft. tall, and wide. Neat, compact habit, with tiers of arching or drooping branches. Flower colors range from white to pink or purple depending on the variety. A beautiful shrub, good in foreground, raised beds or as a specimen.

Botanical Name: *Lysimachia nummularia*
Common Name: MONEYWORT

Flowers: Yellow six pedal flower

Foliage: Light yellow green leaves that look like small coins

Bloom Time: Summer-Fall

General: Full sun to partial shade, reaching a height of 6 – 12 in. tall. Forms a pretty light green mat of roundish leaves. Flowers about 1 in. across, yellow, form singly in leaf joints.

An easy to grow ground cover that can be used covering banks or stone walls, naturalizing around streams or pools.



Botanical Name: *Nandina domestica*
Common Name: HEAVENLY BAMBOO

Flowers: Large clusters of small star shaped flowers.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Spring flowers.

General: Sun or shade; colors better in sun, slow to moderate growth 6 – 8 ft. tall.

This bamboo-like shrub is grown for its finely textured foliage, and upright cane-like stems. Nandina is a remarkable shrub that adds a quiet beauty to the garden all year round. Nandina can be used in virtually any part of the landscape.

Botanical Name: *Perovskia atriplicifolia*
Common Name: RUSSIAN SAGE

Flowers: Tiny tubular flowers grow in clusters on tall spikes
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green, Grey
Bloom Time: Summer

General: Full sun. Extremely popular plant reaching a height of 4 ft. tall and 4 ft. wide. Very long flowering period with airy spires of many blue to light blue blooms. Fragrant (when bruised) foliage and ease of growth. Attracts butterflies and is deer resistant. Extremely resistant to heat and drought.

Perovskia can be used in the middle or back of the border, or any other place in the landscape. It is also useful in separating stronger colors. Use it as a specimen in small areas, in mass to intensify its presence in larger



Botanical Name: *Prunus caroliniana* 'Monus'
Common Name: BRIGHT 'N TIGHT(TM) CAROLINA LAUREL

Flowers: Bowl-shaped flowers in dense clusters
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green
Bloom Time: Spring

General: Full sun, evergreen shrub or tree. As an upright shrub it can be a hedge or tall screen to 20 ft. tall. Trained as a tree, it will become broad topped and reach 35 – 40 ft. tall.

Very attractive with dense foliage of glossy green, smooth edged long leaves. A superb choice for hedges or screens.

Botanical Name: Rhus lancea
Common Name: AFRICAN SUMAC

Flowers: small, inconspicuous flowers are presented as much-branched sprays which are greenish-yellow in color

Foliage: trifoliate (a compound leaf with three leaflets), possessing narrowly lanceolate (lance shaped) leaflets

Bloom Time: Spring

General: Full sun, slow grower to 20 – 30 ft. tall, 20 – 35 ft. wide. Open, spreading habit; Graceful weeping outer branchlets. Dark green leaves.

Evergreen and drought resistant, Rhus does not have an aggressive root system and can be used near paving. Use as a specimen, background, or screen. Good near patios and walkways.



Botanical Name: Phoenix roebelenii
Common Name: PIGMY DATE PALM

Flowers: Large weeping clusters of small unremarkable flowers that are lost in the foliage until the fruit that follows, matures.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Spring

General: Can be grown in shade to full sun and reach a height of 6 ft. tall, with feather like palm leaves and small yellow flowers hanging in clusters.

The Phoenix Roebelenii (*Pigmy Date Palm*) is one of the more graceful and delicate looking of all palm varieties, but actually very hardy, drought tolerant and very long lived if planted in the correct environment. The Phoenix can adapt to the worst soil conditions from very heavy clay to a sandy soil low in nutrients.

Botanical Name: *Tulbaghia violacea* 'Tricolor'
Common Name: TRI-COLOR SOCIETY GARLIC

Flowers: Dainty tubular flowers grow on erect stems in small clusters
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green, Blue, Grey
Bloom Time: Spring to winter

General: Full sun, dense clumps of straight, narrow, evergreen leaves send up slim, 1 – 2 ft. stems topped by clusters of small, trumpet-shaped, pinkish lavender flowers.

Used as a low border. Continuous blooms during the warm season. Low-maintenance plant. Very drought tolerant. Useful for the edge of the pond or even in shallow water.



Botanical Name: *Sutera Cordata* 'Snowstorm'
Common Name: BACOPA 'SNOWSTORM'

Flowers: Small five petal flowers
Foliage: Dark Green
Bloom Time: Spring


General: Sun or shade, Bacopa reaches a height of 1 ft. tall and a width up to 2 ft.

Bacopa answers the dilemma of gardeners in search of long blooming plants; it flowers without interruption for months on end.

Botanical Name: Schinus molle

Common Name: CALIFORNIA PEPPER TREE

Flowers: Abundant tiny flowers in drooping clusters

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Summer

General: Full sun, fast growth to 25 – 40 ft. tall and wide. A strikingly handsome tree, probably the brightest green of desert-tolerant trees.

A fine tree for shading an area for informal lounging. California Pepper is a characteristic tree of landscape gardens.

Botanical Name: Abelia x 'Edward Goucher'

Common Name: EDWARD GOUCHER PINK ABELIA

Flowers: Small, trumpet-shaped flowers, 3/4 inch long.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Summer.

General: Full sun, reaching a height of 6 – 8 ft. (sometimes 10 ft.) tall, with a width of 6 ft. Spreading rounded shrub with glossy dark green leaves that sometimes tinge bronze. White 3/4" fragrant flowers from summer to frost. Purplish pink flowers from spring through fall.

Can be used as a hedge plant. Can be used as a grouping plant.

Botanical Name: Betula pendula

Common Name: EUROPEAN WHITE BIRCH

Flowers: Pendulous catkins in spring. Not ornamental.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Spring.

General: This graceful, deciduous tree provides a display in every season, even looks stunning in winter. Plant in full sun or light dappled shade. With upright branching, weeping side branches, this delicate and lacy tree can reach 30-40 ft. tall. Bark on trunk and main limbs becomes white, marked with black clefts. Rich green, glossy leaves to 2-1/2" long, diamond shaped with slender tapered point.



Botanical Name: Escallonia 'Compakta'

Common Name: ESCALLONIA

Flowers: Deep, Rose Pink

Foliage: Bright Green

Bloom Time: All year

General: Sun near coast, part shade inland, reaching a height up to 3 ft. tall. Wind hardy, clean looking, with glossy leaves.

Escallonia is an evergreen shrub with clusters of rose-red flowers. Colorful and fast growing. Excellent for hedge or in borders.

Botanical Name: *Dodonaea viscosa* 'Purpurea'
Common Name: PURPLE HOPSEED BUSH

Flowers: Inconspicuous, attractive pinkish winged seed head in summer.
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green, White, Variegated
Bloom Time: Spring.

General: Full sun or light shade, fast growing, reaching heights of 12 – 15 ft. tall.

Tough, tolerant shrubs with many upright stems and willow-like leaves to 4 in. long. Can be pruned as a hedge or espalier, it takes any kind of soil, ocean winds, dry desert heat. Good plant for blocking unsightly views.



Botanical Name: *Buxus microphylla japonica*
Common Name: JAPANESE BOXWOOD

Flowers: Inconspicuous, fragrant white flowers.
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green
Bloom Time: Early to late spring.

General: Full sun or shade, growing slowly to 4 – 6 ft. tall. If not pruned, makes a pleasing informal green shrub.

Widely used for edging and hedging with compact foliage (small, 1/3 – 1 in. round tipped leaves) is lively bright green in summer, brown or bronze in winter in many places.

Botanical Name: *Euonymus fortunei* 'Golden Prince' PP 3211
Common Name: GOLDEN PRINCE(R) EUONYMUS

Flowers: Inconspicuous

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green, White, Variegated

Bloom Time: Spring

General: Best in full sun or light shade, evergreen vine or shrub. Vigorous grower to 4 ft. tall and wide.

Euonymus is highly valued for their foliage, texture, and form; they are almost always used as landscape structure plants. 'Golden Prince' has yellow tipped leaves on new growth, older leaves turn green. Extremely hardy.



Botanical Name: *Hebe 'Evansii'*
Common Name: HEBE

Flowers: Red-Purple

Foliage: Dark Green

Bloom Time: Summer

General: Full sun on coast, partial shade inland. Evergreen, reaching a height to 3 ft. tall. Excellent landscaping plants grown principally for form and foliage.

'Evansii' with its 2 in. long leaves are a blend of dark green and reddish purple; reddish purple flowers that bloom in summer.

Botanical Name: Hebe x 'Patty's Purple'
Common Name: PATTY'S PURPLE HEBE

Flowers: N/A
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green
Bloom Time: Summer

General: Full sun on coast, partial shade inland. Evergreen, reaching a height to 3 ft. tall. Excellent landscaping plants grown principally for form and foliage.

'Patty's Purple' has wine red stems; leaves 1/2 in. long, dark green. Purple flowers on slender spikes in summer. Mass in groups or use in the back of a flower border.



Botanical Name: Lysimachia nummularia
Common Name: MONEYWORT

Flowers: Yellow
Foliage: Light Green
Bloom Time: Spring through Summer

General: Evergreen creeping plant that takes full sun on the coast and shade inland, reaching a height of 6 – 12 in. tall. Forms pretty light green mat of roundish leaves. Flowers about 1 in. across, yellow form singly in leaf joints.

Moneywort is an easy to grow ground cover that can be used to cover banks or stone walls, naturalizing around streams or pools.

Botanical Name: Photinia x fraseri

Common Name: FRASER'S PHOTINIA

Flowers: Small saucer-shaped, 5-petaled flowers in clusters

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Spring

General: Full sun, evergreen shrub or small tree, moderate to fast growth to 10 – 15 ft. tall, spreading wider.

Photinia has bright reddish or bronzy young leaves which turn rich green. These multi-branched and densely leafed plants are useful as informal hedges, background plants, screens and as a large point of interest shrub.

Botanical Name: *Pinus canariensis*
Common Name: CANARY ISLAND PINE

Flowers: Insignificant.
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green
Bloom Time: Spring.

General: Full sun, fast to 60 ft. tall, sometimes shorter. In youth a slender, graceful pyramid. Later a tiered structure.

Canary Island pines are identified by their tall and slender structure. They have three needles per fascicle that are generally between 9 – 12 inches long and are blue green in youth, dark green when older.

Botanical Name: Verbena peruviana 'Saint Paul' (V. x 'Sissinghurst')
Common Name: SAINT PAUL VERBENA

Flowers: Small salverform flowers (tubular, spreading at the mouth) grow in dense clusters on spikes

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Spring

General: Full sun, spreads rapidly, forms a very flat mat, reaching a height of 6 – 12 in. tall, and 18 – 24 in. wide.

Intense color! Clusters of brilliant bright flowers 1/2 to 3/4" long blanket the dark green, tooth-margined foliage for months. Delightful wherever you plant it, but especially lovely cascading over rocks, weaving around taller plants in a border or spilling over the edge of a pot. Verbena is also effective planting in parking strips, along driveways, on dry banks, and walls.

Botanical Name: Abutilon hybridum 'Roseus'

Common Name: PINK FLOWERING MAPLE

Flowers: Bell shaped, drooping.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green

Bloom Time: Heaviest in spring-summer.

General: Full sun on the coast, partial shade inland. Can reach heights up to 8 – 10 ft. tall. A mature Flowering Maple provides a splendid show of color throughout the spring and early summer, with masses of flowers produced at the tip of branches.

Commonly known as the flowering maple, these tropical and semi-tropical shrubs are prized for their rapid growth and plentiful, long-lasting blossoms. Graceful stems with maple like to heart-shaped, sometimes speckled, leaves that form a rounded shrub.

Botanical Name: Acorus gramineus 'Variegatus'

Common Name: VARIGATED SWEET FLAG

Flowers: Inconspicuous.

Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green, Golden

Bloom Time: Spring.

General: Full sun, reaching a height to 1 ft. tall, and 1 – 2 ft. wide. Acorus 'Variegated' has a cream colored stripe on dark-green narrow leaves.

A tough perennial that can be grown in a container, bog or as a ground cover. Its grass-like evergreen foliage makes it an excellent accent in a mixed border. It has small flowers ranging from white to lavender, but the foliage is Sweet Flag's crowning glory. Mass as a ground cover, at waters edge along streams or ponds, rock gardens, or as small accent plants.

Botanical Name: Acer palmatum 'Sangu Kaku' Multi
Common Name: JAPANESE MAPLE 'SANGU KAKU' MULTI

Flowers: Purples, Reds
Foliage: Green
Bloom Time: Early Spring to Mid Spring

General: Full sun, but thrives in partial shade, reaching the height up to 25 ft., and 18 – 22 ft. wide. Top choice among small trees for all-season beauty. Wonderful coral-red fall color has made this maple a favorite for years. Even the stems are coral to yellow brown, making for an interesting conversation piece in the winter garden. New leaves emerge reddish, turning green during the growing season.

Use effectively on north and east walls, in patios and entryways, as small lawn trees. Attractive in groves (like Birches) as woodland planting; for natural effect. Good under Oaks, as background for ferns and Azaleas.



Botanical Name: Agapanthus africanus 'Peter Pan'
Common Name: DWARF LILY-OF-THE-NILE

Flowers: Clusters of trumpet-shaped flowers.
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green
Bloom Time: Summer.

General: Full sun or partial shade. Foliage clumps are 8 – 12 in. tall, clustered flowers atop 1 – 1-1/2 ft. stems.

Agapanthus is one of the best known garden plants. Exciting rock garden or border item. Excellent in containers.

Foliage: Forest Green

Bloom Time: December to May

General: Full to partial sun. Slow growth 2 to 3 feet tall and wide. Intensely colored salmon pink single blossoms with darker centers cover plants early to midseason spring. Dense, forest green foliage creates an attractive shrub year around. Compact spreading form is ideal for smaller spaces.

Excellent for most landscape. Good as mass planting, Japanese gardens, ponds, streams, hedge or accent plant.

Foliage: Red

Bloom Time: Spring.

General: Full sun, slow growing to 3 – 4 ft. tall and wide. Compact branches make a wonderful low hedge, barrier planting or single shrub accent. Deep crimson color to foliage.

Botanical Name: *Campanula poscharskyana*
Common Name: SERBIAN BELLFLOWER

Flowers: Open bell-shaped flowers.
Foliage: Dark Green, Green, Light Green
Bloom Time: Summer.





Olive trees thrive in areas with hot, dry summers, but also perform adequately in coastal areas. They are excellent shade trees for around the house.

Known for its toughness and long flowering period, salvia makes a valuable addition to any sunny border. The shrubby evergreen perennial thrives in sunny and dry locations. If you love to watch hummingbirds and butterflies, this is an excellent plant.

The wisteria is known for the beauty of its flowers, which appear in long, cascading racemes and are usually blue, purplish-blue, pink, or white. Wisteria makes a great trellis or arbor vine. It is characterized by its clockwise growing pattern.




